- Go to www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidSG.org
- Look for “First Time Applicants”
 - “Create a Student Account”
 - Complete the required fields
 - Click Submit
 - SAVE the Username and Password automatically generated for you. You will use this to log back in and check on the status of your application once it has been submitted.
- **Fill out the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA)**

All Plant seniors should apply now. Test scores and other requirements can be completed throughout the school year. The College Resource Room is available to complete the online application or you can complete it at home.

It is important for ALL SENIORS to apply regardless of GPA, community service, or test scores. Students going out-of-state or joining the military should also apply. You will have up to 5 years to start using the scholarship; however, you cannot apply after your senior year in high school.

★ **Hints for completing the application:**

*All areas with a **RED asterisk (*)** must be filled out. Do **NOT** use periods, apostrophes, or hyphens; the form only accepts letters and numbers. Use the **TAB** key or the mouse to move to the next question; using the **ENTER** key is the same as clicking the **SUBMIT** button – you will have to start your application over.*

Section A – Demographic Information

- Social Security Number- THIS MUST BE CORRECT
- Graduation Date- 5/23/2022

Section B – Academic Information

- Answer “YES” to “Will you graduate/have you graduated from FL high school”
- Make sure you click “Plant High School” (NOT “Plant City”)
- Enter the college you plan on attending (you can log on later to change this)

Section C – Submit/Acknowledgement

- **Read the “Have you ever been found guilty of...” question carefully!!**
