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The Plant Daily Schedule

The Plant daily schedule consists of 8 periods (7 courses and 1 period for lunch). The core courses make up most of a student's schedule, while the remaining periods include HOPE, reading and/or other electives.

Core Course Teacher Recommendations

- Middle school teachers/staff will make core course recommendations for English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Reading and World Language. Placement is based on performance, grades, and/or FSA/ERB/IOWA/Terranova test scores.
- Any inquiries or requests about recommended course placement must be coordinated directly with the middle school teacher and/or <u>middle school counselor</u>.

AP Course Prerequisites & Requirements

- 3.0 un-weighted GPA. Excellent study habits, completes homework, and enjoys reading. Ability to work independently. Must take AP Exam in May.
- Completion of possible summer assignment. Average of 3-4 hours of HW/night and weekends.

Florida Virtual School-FLVS Information

- Course requests for FLVS courses must be completed online at www.flvs.net by the student.
- Middle School Counselors verify courses requested prior to June 3rd. After June 3rd, <u>students enrolled</u> in FLVS must update the school to Plant High School on the FLVS Academic Profile to ensure the grade is added to PHS transcript upon completion.
- Plant summer staff reviews FLVS requests that are submitted after June 3rd. Course approvals can take place within 1-2 weeks. Go to <u>tinyturl.com/onlineplant</u> for more information.

Service Hours

- Students are permitted to log service hours completed over summer (after completing 8th grade).
- Service hours are logged into the new online system called Profferfish at <u>http://profferfish.com.</u>
- Incoming 9th graders will not have access to Profferfish until <u>July or August</u> but will be able to backdate and submit hours for approval at that time or after school starts.
